Keep this close to your computer and periodically review with your kids. Educate them to be safe Web Surfers!

NEVER post personal information of yours or anyone else.

This includes:

- Your name or other family members' or friends' names
- Your age or birthday
- Home or email address
- Phone numbers
- Where you live- Not even what part of the country!
- Where you go to school
- Financial Information



CYBERBULLYING

- DO NOT put up with cyber bullying
- REPORT cyber bullying right away
- NEVER reply to emails or chat sessions containing threatening or vulgar language, sexually explicit speech, or anything that makes you feel uncomfortable

Internet Safety FOR Families



REMEMBER:

- When online, people may not be who they say they are.
- Share your online experiences with your parents to help them better understand computers, the Internet, Social Networking sites, and your other online interests.
- Think before you post! Always use proper "netiquette" and be a good online citizen.

Username & Screen names

- Your username/screen name should not identify you as a boy or a girl.

DO NOT:

- DO NOT upload your picture or those of your family or friends
- DO NOT fill out online forms, questionnaires, profiles, surveys, etc.
- DO NOT make online purchases without permission, even if it's free
- DO NOT share passwords with anyone except your parents
- DO NOT download software, games, or anything else without permission
- DO NOT open emails or email attachments from people you do not know
- NEVER agree to meet someone you've met online in person.
